

It's first class all the way at Santa Barbara's Inn of the Spanish Garden, from spacious guest rooms with deep soaking tubs and Frette linens to nightly *hors d'oeuvres* and tastings of local wines on the property's bougainvillea-shaded patio. The graceful, two-story Mediterranean building is new, but it blends in perfectly with the surrounding structures (all classic 1920s Spanish architecture). This luxury hotel—the only one in Santa Barbara's historic Presidio district—has just 23 rooms, each with a fireplace and private balcony or patio. Best of all is the Majestic Suite, with its 10-foot vaulted ceilings, king-sized bed, DVD player, Mexican Saltillo tile, bathroom skylight and a pair of balconies. The "Hearts With Wings Package" caters to the jet set: Book a private plane through the hotel, as well as a car and driver while in town. Guests with their own planes can call the hotel to make arrangements for limo pickup at Santa Barbara airport.
